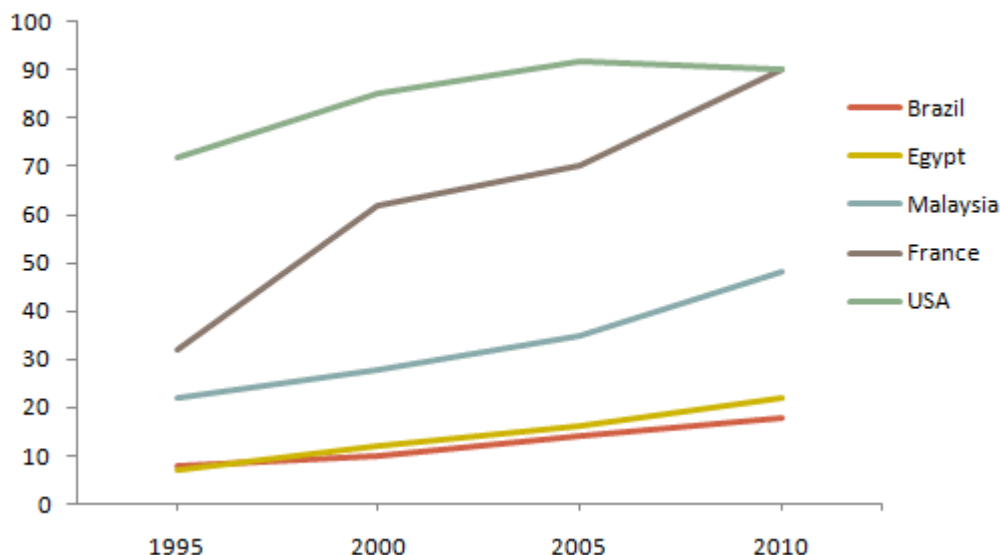


IELTS WRITING TASK 1

Q-The graph below gives information about international tourist arrivals in five countries.

Summarise the information by selecting and reporting the main features, and make comparisons where relevant.

International Tourist Arrivals (millions)



Model answer

Between 1995 and 2010, the graph depicts the total number of tourist arrivals in five nations. In 1995, for example, more than 70 million tourists visited the United States, more than twice as many as the next most popular destination in France. However, between 2005 and 2010, visitors visiting the United States decreased by about 1,500,000, whereas tourists visiting France increased by about 20 million. As a result, the number of tourists visiting the United States and France in 2010 was nearly equal, with each country receiving around 90 million visitors.

Over time, the number of visitors visiting Malaysia increased rapidly, but by 2010, the total was still under 50 million. Brazil and Egypt were the countries with the fewest tourist arrivals. Between 1995 and 2000, the number of tourists visiting both countries was similar, although Egypt saw a more significant rise in visitors than Brazil.
