Q-Families who do not send their children to government-financed schools should not be required to pay taxes that support universal education.

-Give reasons for your answer and include any relevant examples from your knowledge or experience.

MODEL ANSWER : **(Disagree)**

Families who do not send their children to public school should be obligated to pay taxes to support public education.

Every child in my country must attend school, and all children are welcome to enroll in their local public school. Some families choose to send their children to other schools, which is entirely their choice. However, most of our children attend public schools, which must remain open to all. My uncle, for example, sent his two children to a private academy for elementary school. Then he lost a significant amount of money due to poor investment decisions, and he could no longer afford private school tuition.

Because public schools educate so many people, everyone in my country—parent or not—should pay taxes to support our educational system.
