Q-In many countries, the proportion of older people is steadily increasing. What problems will this cause for individuals and society? Suggest some measures that could be taken to reduce the impact of aging populations.

Indeed, people in developed countries can now expect to live longer than ever before.

Although this tendency will likely have some negative implications, societies can work to alleviate these issues.

As people live longer lives and developed countries age, many linked issues are likely to emerge. The fundamental concern is that more people will be eligible for a pension as they reach retirement age. As a result, the proportion of younger, working individuals would decrease, and governments would collect fewer taxes based on population size. To put it another way, an aging population will impose a more significant tax burden on working adults. In addition, an increase in the need for healthcare and the reality that young adults will increasingly be responsible for their older relatives will add to the difficulties.

Governments could take several steps to address the issues mentioned above. To begin with, a simple option would be to raise the retirement age for working persons from 65 to 70 years old. People in this age group nowadays are generally healthy enough to continue working. Governments should also encourage immigration to increase the number of working adults who pay taxes. Finally, national finances will need to be diverted from other sectors to provide critical healthcare, housing, and transportation for the growing number of senior persons.

Finally, different measures can be implemented to address the issues that will inevitably occur as countries age.
