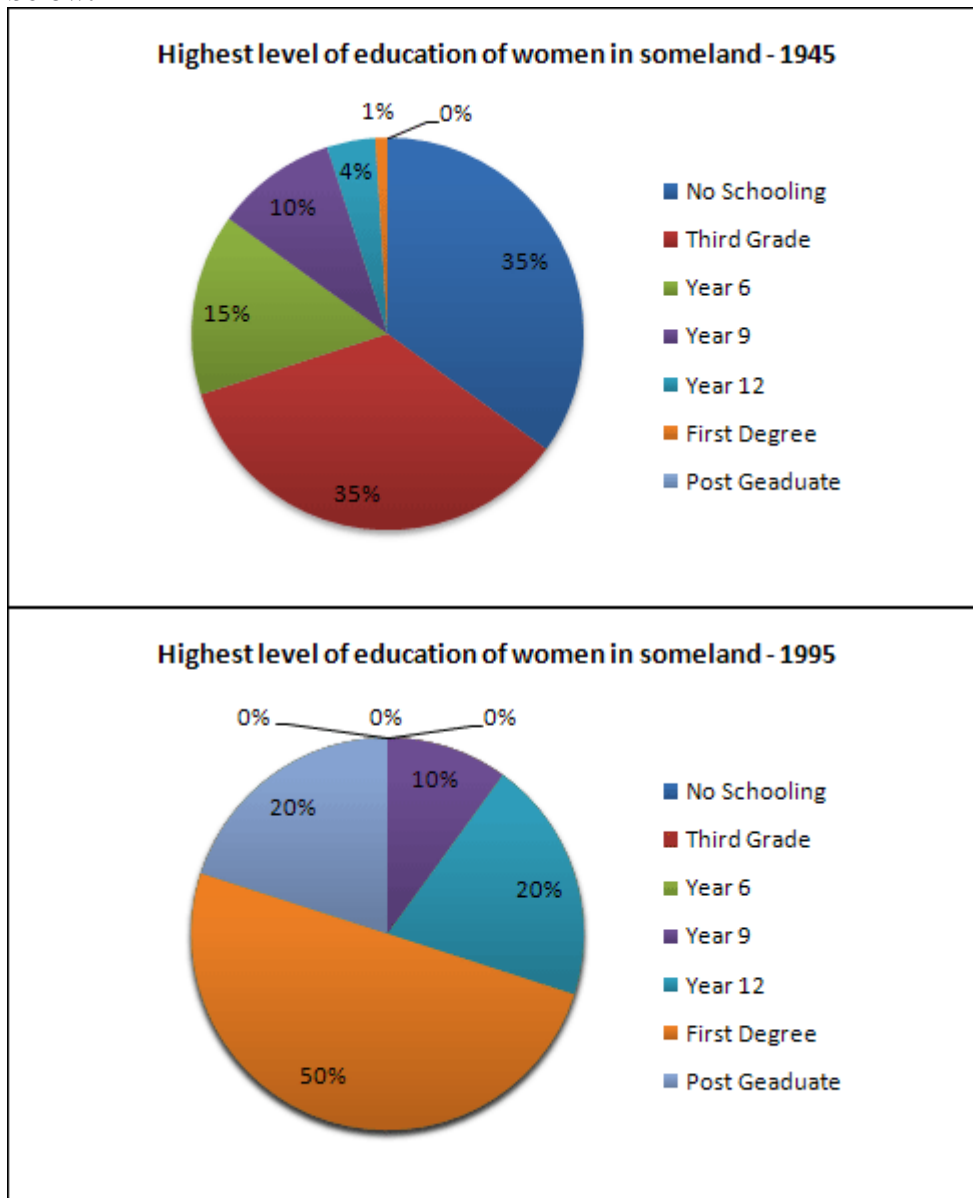


IELTS WRITING TASK 1

Q-Write a report for a university lecturer describing the information in the two graphs below.



Model answer:

The pie charts show the most significant degree of education attained by women in Homeland from 1945 to 1995. Thus, it can be shown that in 1995, women in Homeland had a substantially greater degree of education than they did in 1945.

Only 30% of women finished secondary school in 1945, and only 1% went on to get a bachelor's degree. Moreover, there had been no women who had completed postgraduate studies. However, by 1995, the situation had drastically shifted. In 1995, 90% of women in Homeland had completed secondary school, with half of those graduating with an associate's degree and 20% continuing to postgraduate study. On the other hand, we can observe that by 1995, all girls had completed lower secondary school. However, 10% had dropped out at this stage. This was in stark contrast to 1945 when just 30% of girls finished elementary school, 35% had no education, and 35% had passed the third grade.

Finally, we can see that there have been significant improvements in women's educational levels in Homeland throughout the 50 years from 1945 to 1995.
